That's Amore is a low-budget comedy mockumentary set in a lively Brooklyn neighborhood, centered on Joey, a passionate but stubborn old-school pizza shop owner in his mid-50s who refuses to let his beloved family business fall apart. Despite presenting himself as a traditional Italian restaurateur, Joey is unmistakably British, adding to the everyday absurdity of the restaurant.

Working beside him is his ambitious but often misguided son Tony, a twenty-something delivery manager convinced he can modernize the business with new ideas that usually create more chaos than success. Their ongoing clash between tradition and change drives much of the conflict inside the shop.

The staff is just as unpredictable: Mya, the sharp and capable assistant manager who also handles deliveries and keeps the restaurant running; Mario, the temperamental head chef, treats pizza like an art form;

Jenna, the witty cashier, observes everything and often plays detective; and Carly, the energetic host, tries to help but often adds to the madness. As a documentary crew captures their daily lives, the team navigates demanding customers, neighborhood rivalries, and constant workplace chaos. Through awkward interviews and outrageous situations, *That's Amore* reveals that the pizza shop is more than just a restaurant. It's the heart of the neighborhood, where food, family, and chaos collide every day.
